Re: Supplemental Response to Your Public Records Act Request Dated April 24, 2026

Dear Mr. Reeves:

This correspondence is a supplemental response to your request for records submitted April 24, 2026, and acknowledged May 8, 2026. This response is being provided pursuant to California Government Code section 7920.000 *et seq.* Nothing in this response is a waiver of any applicable exemption or privilege and nothing in this response should be construed as a waiver.

The Visalia Police Department has identified and is prepared to provide the following records related to the request. The public records being produced with this supplement response include:

As it relates to request 1: **System Access & Inter-Agency Sharing Logs – Any and all records, audit logs, or documentation showing access to data compiled by the VPD via the Flock Safety ALPR system by an agency other than the Visalia Police Department:**

- Flock Shared Networks (6 pages) is a current list of all agencies with whom VPD has a data-sharing arrangement with for purposes of ALPR. There is no formal contract or written agreement for this purpose.
- The remainder of this portion of your request will be provided on a rolling basis. The Department anticipates it will begin producing records on or before June 20, 2026. If able, records will be provided sooner.

As it relates to request 2: **Specific License Plate Records – All records, images and data points captured by the VPD ALPR system (including fixed cameras**

and mobile units) that reference or identify the following California license plate: JJRJR:

- Actual plate number paired with dates, times and locations is shielded from disclosure under the California Public Records Act’s catch-all balancing exemption because the privacy interests of individuals whose plates were scanned clearly outweigh the public interest in disclosure. (Gov. Code § 7922.222; *American Civil Liberties Union Foundation v. Superior Court* (2017) 3.Cal.5th 1032.) Absent credible documentation you are the owner of the vehicle with plate number JJRJR, the record is exempt from disclosure.
- After a diligent search, the Department has determined “Hot List” hits shared with outside agencies is not information retained by the Department. The Department can access the number of hot list hits. That information is being collected and will be provided to you when available.

If you are the registered owner of the vehicle with plate number JJRJR, please provide documentation so indicating and this portion of the request will be re-evaluated.

The Department’s staff is continuing its diligent search and review of requested records. The Department’s staff members estimate they will be able to supplement this response on or about June 20, 2026, earlier if able.

Please note that nothing in this letter should be construed as a representation the Department has all the records requested or that such records (if they exist) are subject to public disclosure under the CPRA.
